³ Average private rents have now been updated to a figure that is produced monthly. PIPR produces rent price and inflation statistics for the UK, tracking prices paid for new and existing tenancies in the private rental sector. This is constructed using administrative rent price data, which means that the index makes use of data that are already collected for other purposes to estimate rental prices. The figure shown is the average monthly private rent and, like house prices, is compared to the value during the same month one year ago to account for seasonal variations.
