

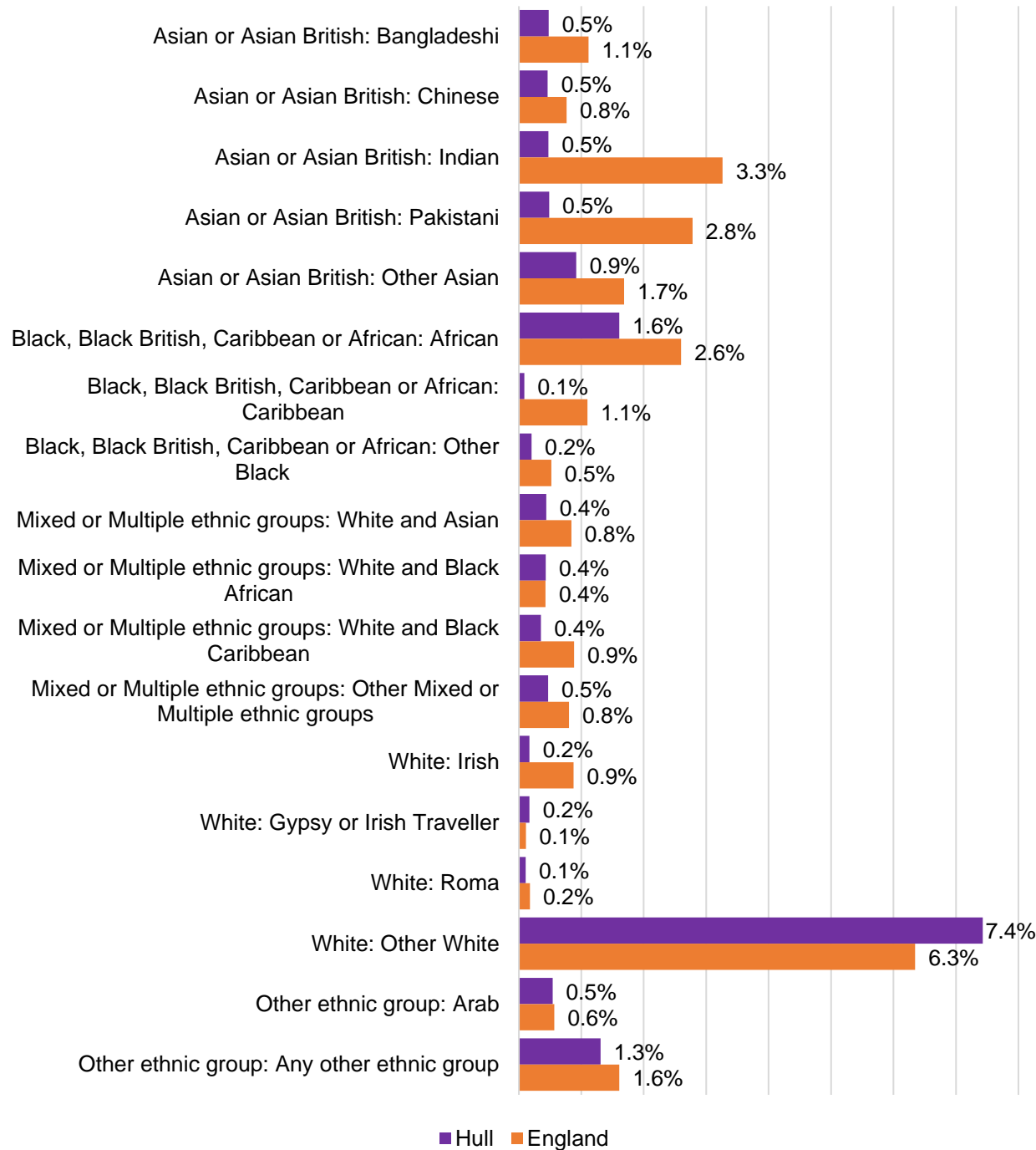

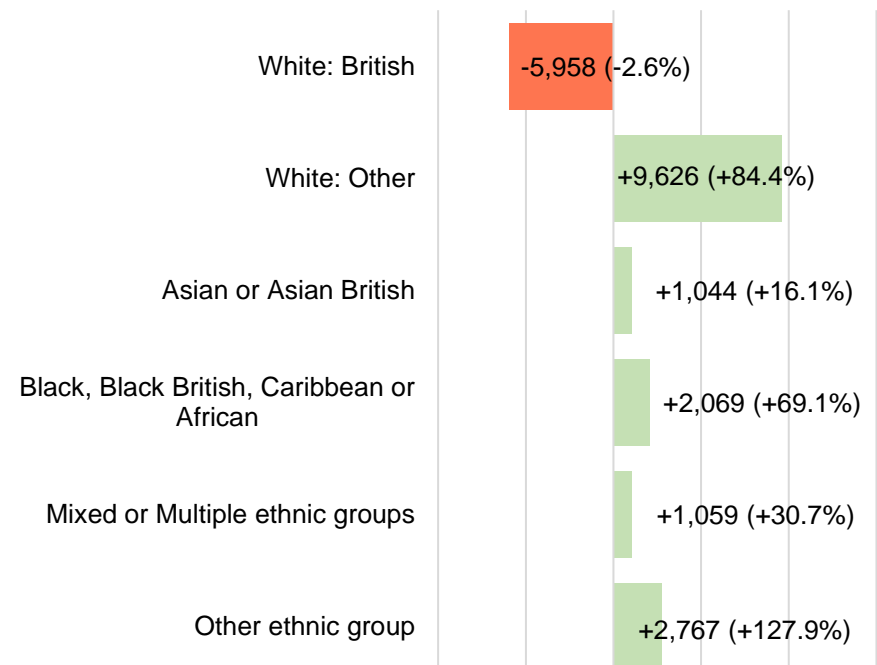

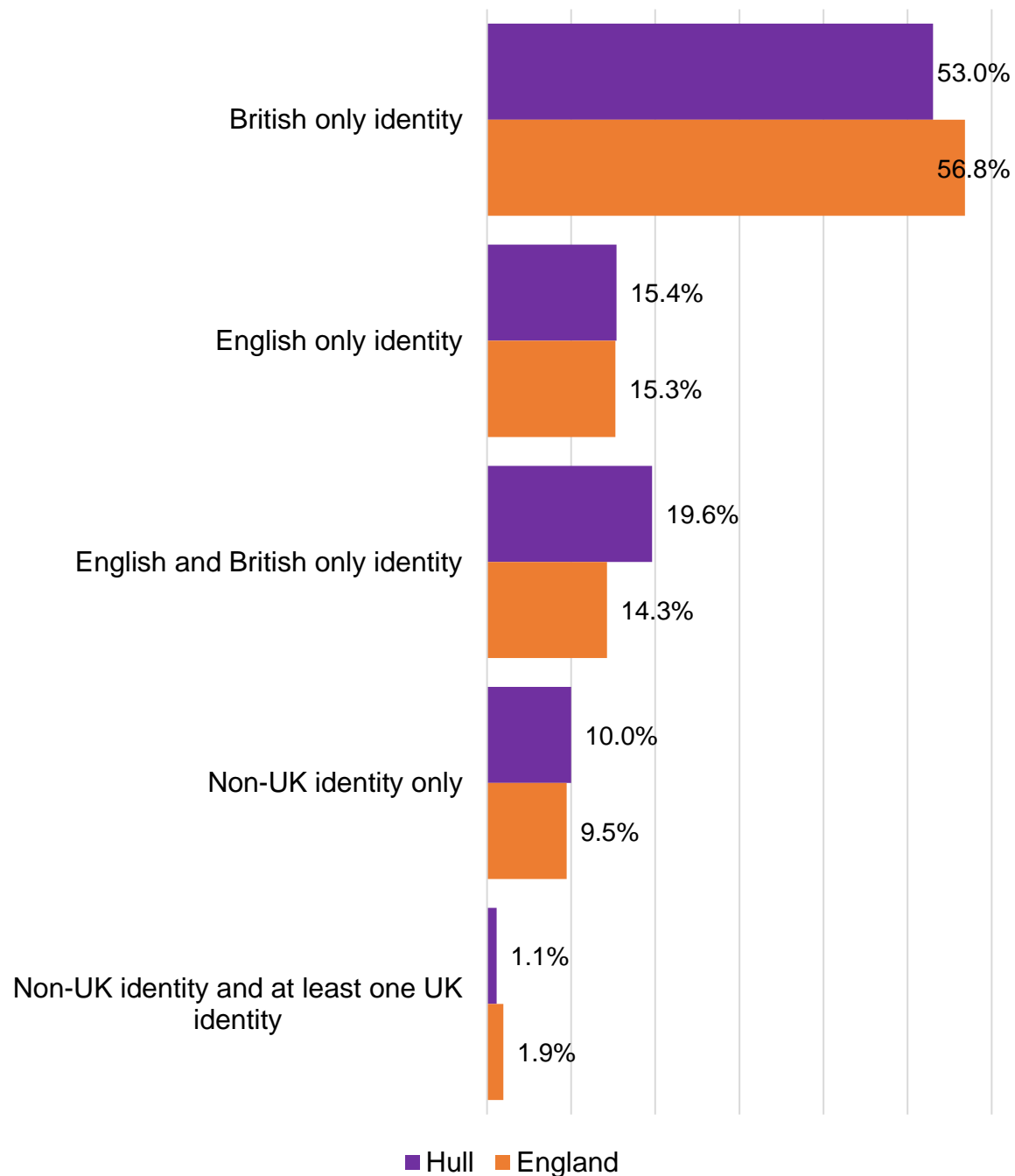

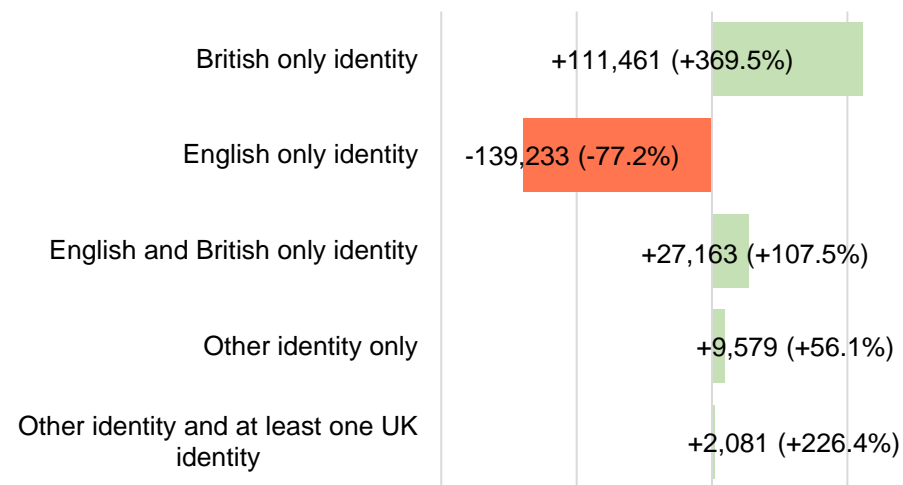

## Change in Hull Since 2011:

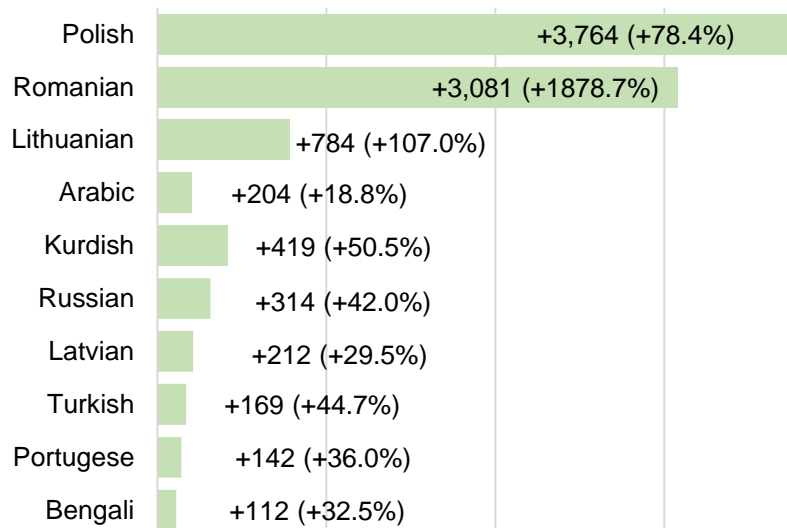

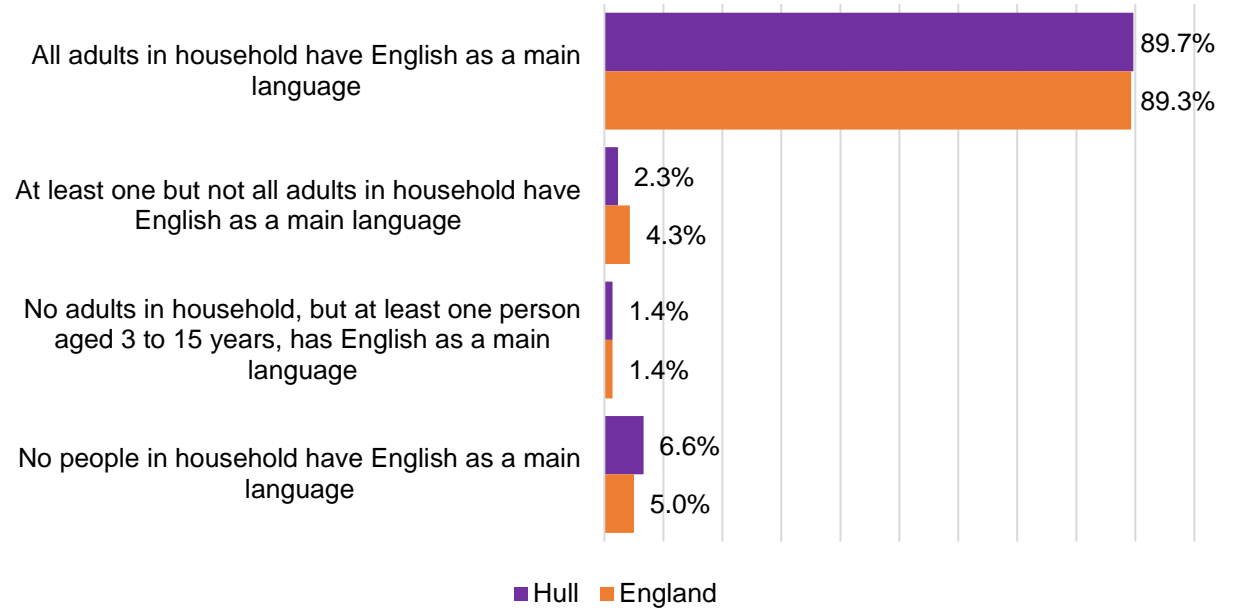
## Top 10 Non-English Main Languages in Hull:



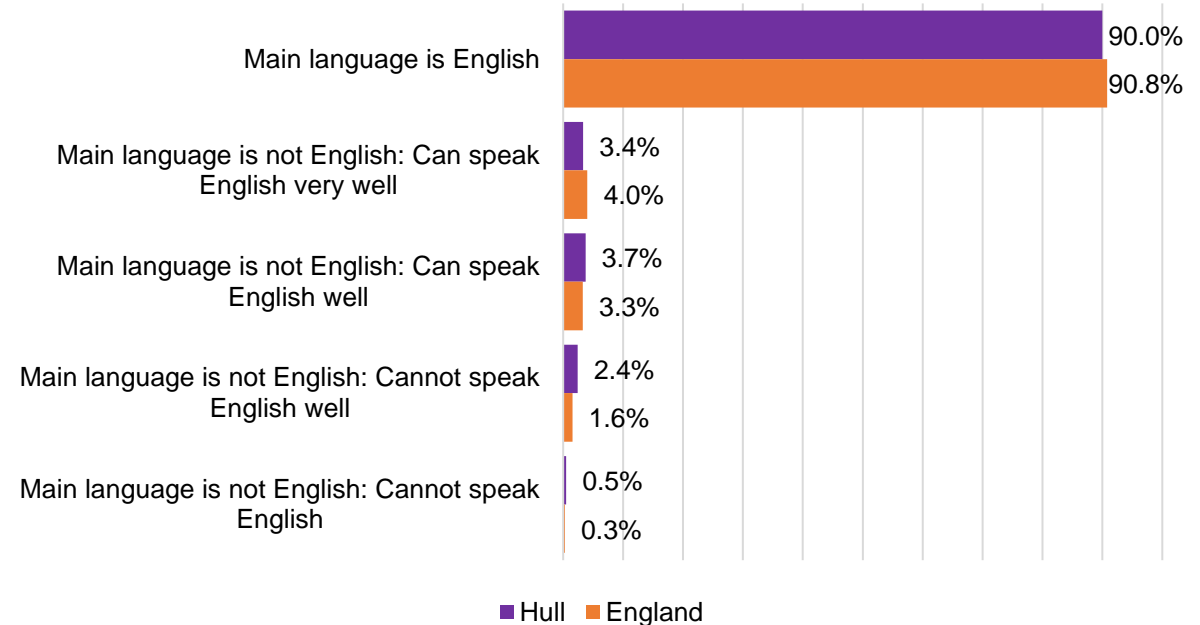

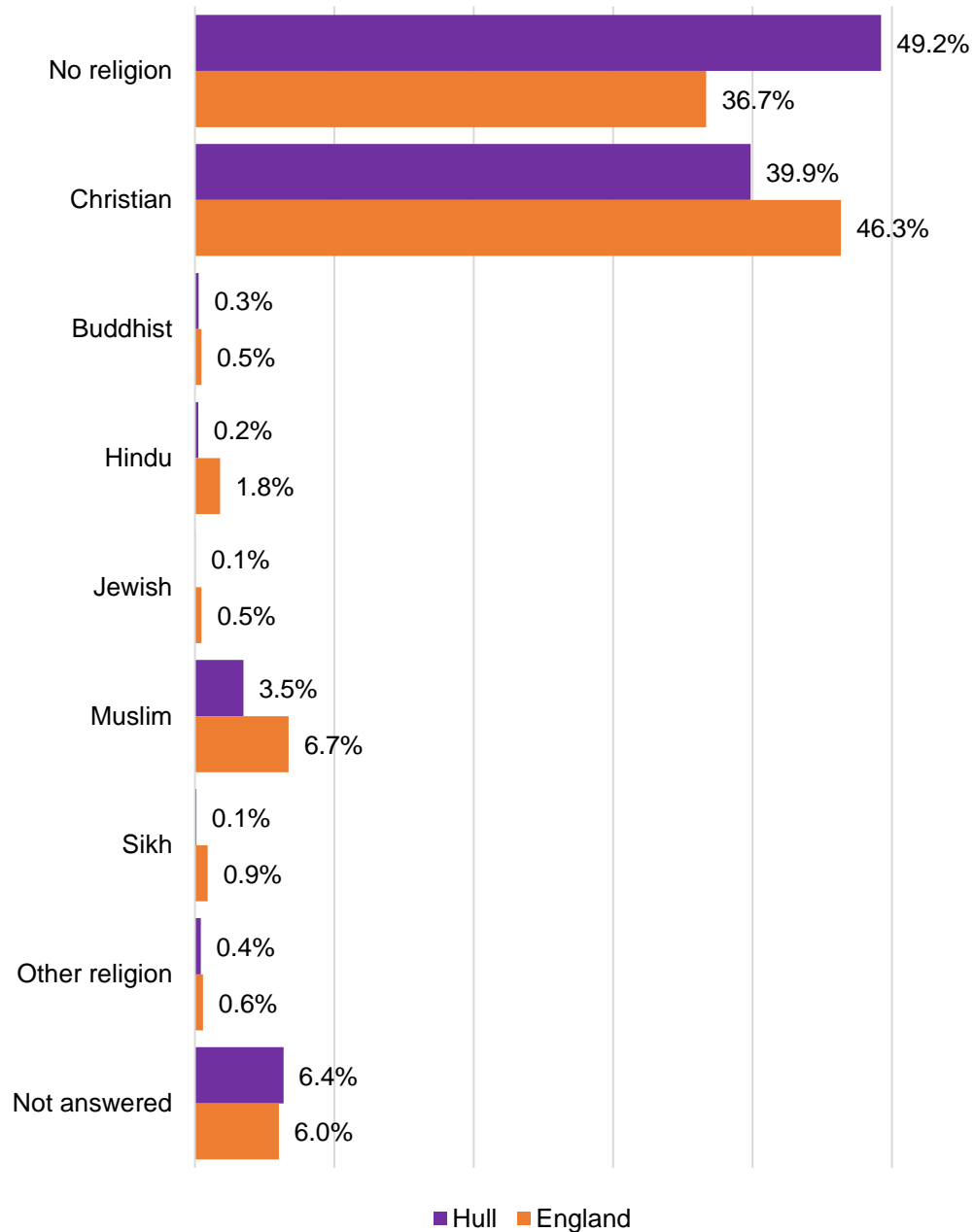


## Population Aged 3+ By Proficiency in English:
